- Woocommerce Estimated Delivery Date Per Product is used for set estimated delivery date for WooCommerce simple product and variable products.
- Site admin can set below features.
- 1. Set estimated delivery date per product
- 2. Set estimated delivery date per product variations.
- 3. Display estimated delivery date on product detail page.
- 4. Display estimated delivery date on cart, checkout and order page.
- 5. Display estimated delivery date in order email.
- 6. Set estimated delivery date text.
- 7. Set estimated delivery date font size and font color.
- 8. Set estimated delivery date format.
- 9. Enable / Disable estimated date text on each product and product variations.
- 10. Enable disable entire plugin functionality.

- 2. WooCommerce2.5+
- 3. jQuery(comes with WordPress3.8+)
- 4. jQueryUI (comes with WordPress3.8+)
- 5. Latest browsers like Firefoxor, Chrome.

Installation Guide

Upload via FTP:

Unzip the .zip file that you have downloaded to your computer and upload to your server via FTP to the plugin directory of your wordpress installation (wp-content > plugins).

• Upload via WordPress Admin:

Go to your wordpress admin panel, and then click to plugins. Click on "AddNew" and then upload the zip file of the plugin with the Upload Plugin button.


Activate the Plugin

Once you uploaded your plugin successfully you will find **Woocommerce Estimated Delivery Date Per Product** in your plugin list. Click on activate That's It!

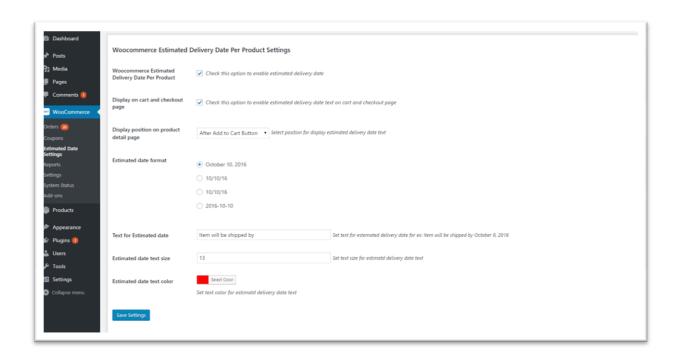
How to setup and use plugin?

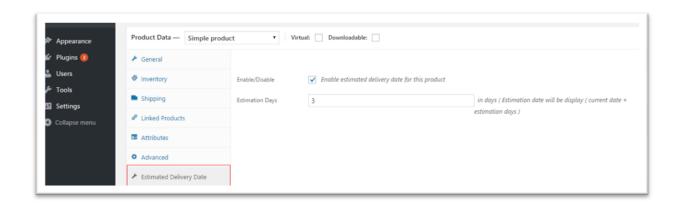

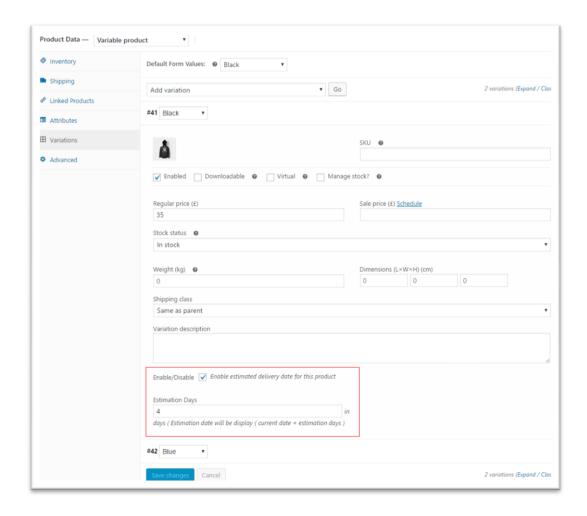
2. Screenshot (Estimated Delivery Date settings page)



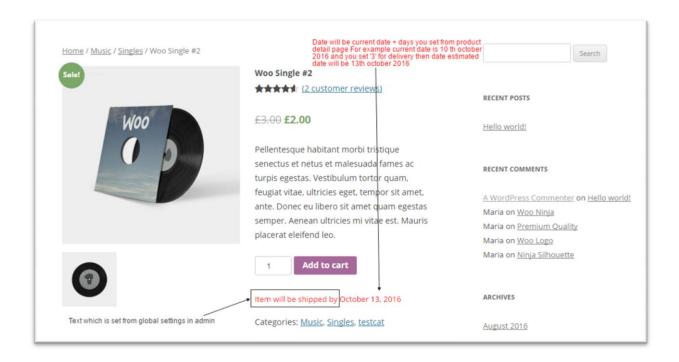
3. Screenshot (Set estimated date for simple product type)



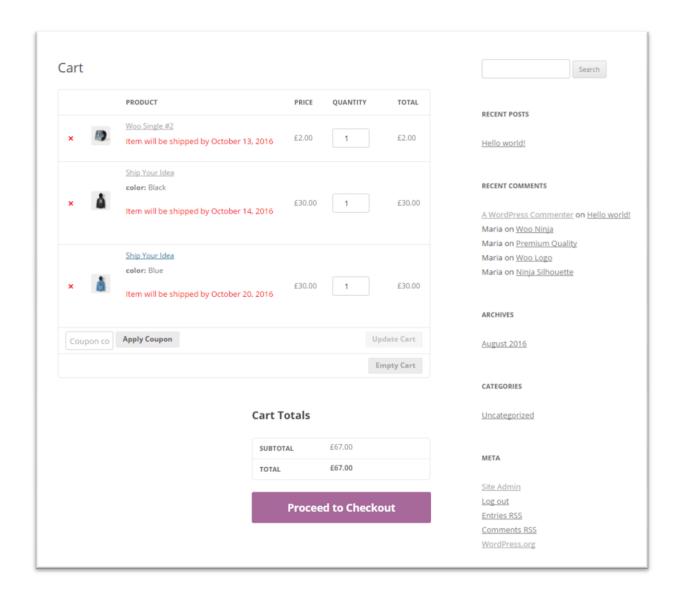
4. Screenshot (Set estimated date for variable product type)



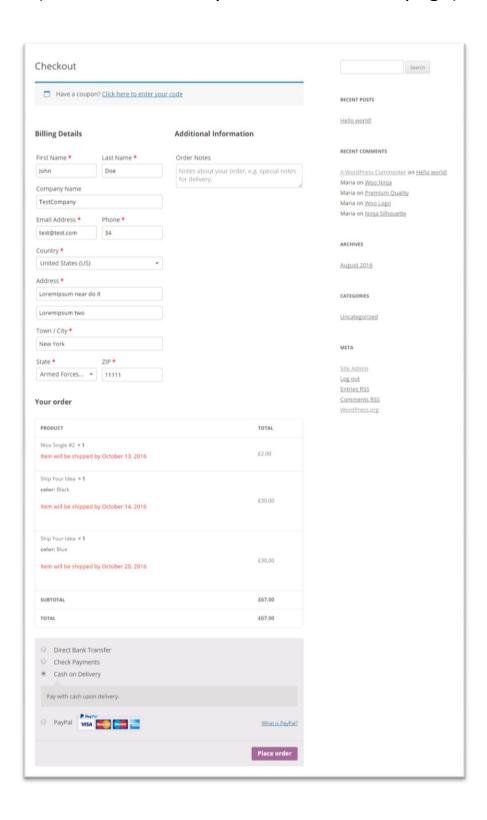
5. Screenshot Plugin in Action (Estimated date text on product detail page)



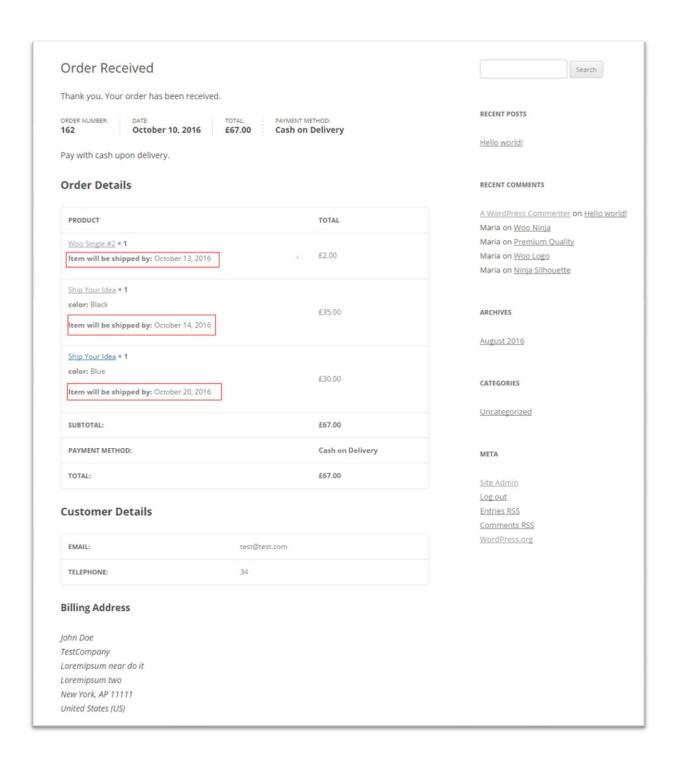
6. Screenshot (Estimated delivery date on cart page)



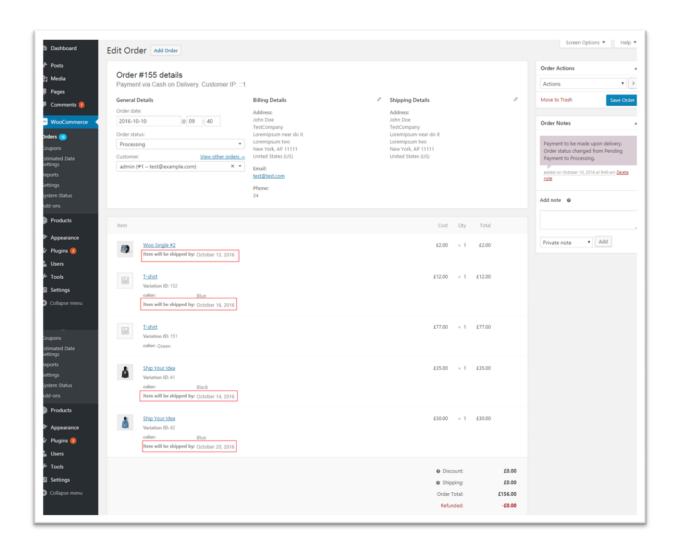
